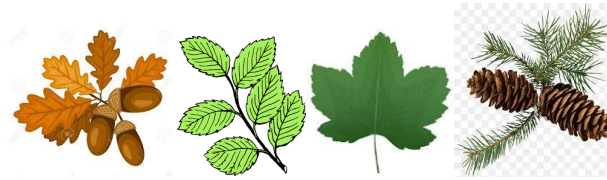

Please also send your child in with **additional shoes** to wear at lunchtime as we will be going up to the field as often as is possible.

If you change your **mobile number** please inform the school office as soon as possible as it is imperative that we have your current contact information.

**Uniform** - The school is proud of its image and seeks to promote a high standard of dress to help give the children a sense of pride in the school. Therefore please can you ensure that your child is appropriately dressed for school in line with our school policy.

Winter

- Grey trousers/Skirt/pinafore
- Green sweatshirt/cardigan - with the school badge
- White long sleeved shirt
- Green and silver striped tie
- Green or black tights with skirts/dresses
- Black shoes

If your child has **pierced ears** they may wear small plain studs.

**Long hair** should be tied up. Hair-bands should be in a colour sympathetic to the uniform (green, black, grey, white).

All clothes should be clearly **labelled** with your child's name.

Please note that the wearing of rings, bracelets, earrings and necklaces is discouraged, as these may be dangerous in play situations. Nail varnish and tattoo stickers should not be worn to school.

**Illness**- although attendance is crucial please do not send your child into school if they are unwell. Children with temperatures should be kept at home, especially if they have additional symptoms like a headache. If your child is sick or has diarrhoea they must be kept home until 48 hours past the last episode. This poster is a little handy guide

# Should I keep my child off school?



## Yes

### Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

## No

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about..

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
